What is the Senior Center?

Everett Senior Center, located at 702 Burchfield Street in Maryville, offers a variety of activities, classes, and health programs for senior adults. We operate as part of the Parks and Recreation Commission.

- **Membership is open to anyone age 50 and over.** The yearly membership fee is \$15.00 for an individual and \$25.00 per couple.
- **There is a large multi-purpose room** used for dancing, exercise programs, Wii, health care screenings, seminars, and meeting space for large groups.
- **A smaller meeting and class room** is available for smaller groups, lunch and learn seminars, blood pressure clinics, and learning cards.
- **A generous kitchen area** adjoins to the large multi-purpose room.
- **The Billiard room** holds 3 standard size tables and are free for our members.
- **The card room** is the most used room in the building with its 20+ square card tables.

What can I do there?

Our members enjoy art classes, quilting groups, dancing, Tai Chi, Tone and Stretch, billiards, health and wellness programs, and many other activities.

“Mid Week Music” featuring local talent, every month on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday. The program begins at 10:00 am. Spectators are Welcomed to join this free event!! Sponsored by Blount Memorial Hospital.

Classes in the Art room include oil and watercolor painting and Quilting groups. A small fee is charged by the instructors of these classes. Center Members pay a discounted rate.

Pot Luck lunch is held on the first Thursday of each month at 11:30am, followed by free bingo with prizes sponsored by WoodmenLife.

Ballroom Dancing is held on Wednesday afternoons, free lessons offered from 1:00 until 2:00pm, with dancing after 2:00 to 3:30 pm. A live band is scheduled on the 1st, 3rd and 5th Saturdays from 7:00pm to 9:00 pm. A small fee is collected at the door for these dances.



Educational seminars of interest to seniors and health screening events are regularly scheduled. Our facility is a meeting site for many social services such as AARP and Blount County Health Department educational seminars.
