

What is the Senior Center?

Everett Senior Center, located at 702 Burchfield Street in Maryville, offers a variety of activities, classes, and health programs for senior adults.

Membership is open to anyone age 60 or older, with an associate membership available to anyone aged 50 and above. The annual membership fee is \$15 for an individual and \$25 per couple; this membership includes a mailed or emailed bi-monthly newsletter as well as discounts on various paid classes and trips.

The Center is open for regular activities Monday through Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Friday 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

There is a large multi-purpose room used for dancing, exercise programs, Wii, health care screenings, seminars, and meeting space for large groups. Smaller meeting and class rooms are nearby. A generous kitchen area adjoins these spaces. Computers are available for Center members. Three regulation size tables are available in the billiards room.

We operate as part of the Parks and Recreation Commission.

What can I do there?

Our members enjoy art, quilting, poetry club, dancing, card groups, billiards, health and wellness programs, and many other activities. Bi-monthly day trips are offered by Mountain Memory Tours.

“Mid Week Music” featuring local talent, every month on the 2nd Wednesday. Sign up to participate at 8:30 a.m. Program begins at 9:00 a.m.– 11:00 a.m. Spectators are welcomed!

A potluck lunch is held the first Thursday of each month at 11:30 a.m., followed by free bingo with prizes (sponsored by Woodmen of the World).

There is dancing to taped music on Wednesday afternoons, free lessons offered 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. with dancing after from 2:00 to 3:30 p.m.

A live band is scheduled on the 1st and 3rd Saturday's from 7 – 9 p.m.. A small fee is collected at the door for these dances. Seating is available, guests are welcome! Non-dancers can enjoy the wonderful music.

What kind of classes can I take at the Center?

Classes in arts and crafts, including oil, acrylics and watercolor painting are available on a regular basis. A small fee will be charged by the instructor for these classes. Center Members pay a discounted rate.

Educational seminars of interest to seniors and health screening events are regularly scheduled. Our facility is a meeting site for many social services. Senior caregivers support groups are hosted by BMH. The AARP meets monthly and also offers free seasonal tax assistance.

Directions to the Center

From Knoxville

Take Alcoa Hwy. (Hwy. 129) pass the airport. At the fork on 129 take the left into town on Hall Road. Continue to the 3rd light. At Broadway turn left . Go to the roundabout making a right onto Everett High Road. Approx. 1 mile turn left into Everett Park. The Center is located at top of hill by red barn.

From Sevierville/Seymour/Townsend

Follow Sevierville Road (Hwy. 411) from Seymour into Maryville. After Coulter Florist (on left) turn right at the first light (BP Station) onto Everett High Road. Go to the first street and turn right on Kittrell, go to stop and make a left onto Burchfield.

From Lenoir City

Take Hwy. 321 into Maryville continue past Shoney's to the 3rd traffic light. Turn left onto Broadway & continue straight, crossing Washington Street. Continue to the roundabout and make a right onto Everett High Rd.. Approx. 1 mile on left turn into Everett Park and drive by the red barn at top of hill.
